I've created a strongly typed DataSet (Customers.xsd) using the xsd.exe tool. I want to be able to access fields using ds.Customer[0].CompanyName.

The problem is when I return this DataSet from a Web Service it adds another Table to the DataSet that contains the data. I have to access the data using ds.Tables[1].Rows[0]["CompanyName"].ToString(). This defeats the whole purpose of using a strongly typed DataSet.
