Hi all,

I am developing an ASP.NET app that will be deployed into a mixed NT4 & W2K domain. The PDC is running NT4 (I know we should have upgraded by now and it is on the cards but this is what I have to work with).

On my development machine I have an ASPNET user that I assume is my anonymous user, but this user is not present in the domain! Do I need an ASPNET user in the domain?

Can I use the authentication of the user instead on an anonymous user as this is an Intranet app to determine which server and network resources are available? How do I do this?

Does anyone have any useful resources that I should check out that will answer my questions and give me some guidance on deploying to a mixed OS domain? The server running IIS is W2K right now.
