I have a page which needs the user to fill his/her info.
The application needs to get some info about the user (to identify him/her), which he won't be able to change it. This is to avoid trash data..

All the user logs in the system using an id and password. I want to display that user id in the asp.net application.

The application runs inside the firewall and is used internally in our organization.

It sounds like this would be a perfect candidate for ASP.NET 2.0 Login controls and Membership functionality. You just drag and drop the login control onto the form, and, depending on the data source you need to authenticate against, do a little configuration.
