I have an image in the masterpage which works fine everywhere except the login page. I have the login control on a page (login.aspx naturally) and the user is directed to it via forms authentication. On that page, the image in the masterpage is replaced by the default square. Anyone know what's up with this?

I've had this problem. It seems to have happened spontaneously, but there's probably some mind-boggling reason I missed. In my case, Forms Authentication began blocking access to all files, rather than allowing images, CSS files and Javascript files.

I never figured out a real solution, and instead ended up with this inside the 'configuration' tag in web.config. This unblocks all of the specific directories to all users.
