You can do it using POST with some javascript involved.

1. Make empty form

```
<form myname="myform">
```

```
<input type="hidden" name="parameter" value="1">
```

```
</form>
```

2. Your link should look like

```
<a href="javascript:document.myform.submit();">this is a link to submit form</a>
```
