The reason you have to access it through JavaScript is that the clientside scripting is responsible for fetching the images from MS and moving them around as you move around on the map. If you did it using only ASP.NET then you would have to do about a million postbacks to move your map around and create markers, open windows etc.

If you are looking for a map on your page I have made an ASP.NET control for Google Maps which works well (especially the licensed version) – <http://www.reimers.dk>
