you hinted at it enough that I think you think that the .210 dlls are older (a previous version) than the .42 dlls. That is not the case. The .210 dlls I had for ASP.NET are newer than the .42 dlls.

They might have been "newer", although I don't know how that could be, but they belong to an earlier build than the release version.

Maybe the date on your .210 dll's refers to the *download* date, rather than the build date ?
