Are you sure the WebDev.WebServer.exe is included in .NET2.0 redistributable? I'd believe it only comes with .NET2.0 SDK. I've checked a few computers in my office, on which only .NET2.0 framework installed, not 2.0 Framework SDK. There is no WebDev.WebServer.exe in the folder "C:\Windows\Microsoft.NET\Framework\v2.0.50727".

If the "development server" mentioned in OP only has .NET2.0 framework, not SDK, he need to either run IIS, or distribute WebDev.WebServer.exe and make sure it is running when needed.

You need a web server, capable of running ASP.NET.

WebDev.WebServer.exe *is* a web server and it can run ASP.NET.

what files need to be included? (Exe, DLL, etc)

AFAIK, only WebDev.WebServer.exe.

You'll find it in the Windows\Microsoft.net\v2.0.50727 direct
