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Hi Alex,

For standard web page's "Repeater" like functionality, in ASP.NET Mobile application, there are two common approaches:

1) you can have a look at the "ObjectList" control, this is the template databound control in ASP.NET Mobile's standard control collection:

2) As we've discussed in some previous methods. Using DeviceSpecific template is always an options for those HTML/XHTML supported device, and you can define and use standard ASP.NET controls(datalist or repeater) in those specific template:
