Check that:

1. Your project has a file named Resources.strings.resx with its build action set to embedded resource
2. Your project namespace is MultiLanguage (see in your project properties)

If you are still having issues, add this line at the top of your LoadResources and stick a breakpoint on it:

```
Dim s() As String =  
[Assembly].GetExecutingAssembly().GetManifestResourceNames() //check in the  
debugger for the real names of your resources
```
