Both are written in C# using a SQL 2K db.

1. Simple code review ... application is small, but I am new to programming, so I am looking for direction.
2. Suggestions for implementing Genuine Channels product to handle encryption and security.
3. Suggestions for app delivery...right now it is a small windows form bidder/client and admin tool.
4. Ideas for controlling authentication (remoting log-in structure).
5. Up to 4 additional hours of paid tutoring on internet application strategy.
