Thank you for posting in the community!

I tried to reproduce your problem on a normal tree view control with a context menu RightToLeft property set to True, since I'm not familiar with the right to left language, I compared the menu text with the same text I inputed in the Notepad with Right ToLeft on.

For example, if I type follow in design time:

1234567890

123

Then at run-time it shows me:

1234567890

123

Could you get the same output when using the Treeview and ContextMenu class provided by .NET Framework?

Is it a correct result?

If not , please show me the result you got when using the .NET Windows Forms classes, please also show me your expected result, since I don't know what's the correct result for right to left language.
