I'd like to modify the default "basename" for a certain control class of mine. For example, I have a whole series of classes auto-generated like FOOBAR, FOOHELLO, etc. and I want the default names to be FOOBAR1, FOOBAR2, FOOHELLO1, FOOHELLO2, etc. Not fooBAR1, fooBAR2, etc.

I'm OK with also creating the entire unique name (i.e. adding the 1, 2, etc) if that means iterating through the controls on the form. But I just can't figure out how to do either and it is hard to search for (Name) on the Web. I looked at ControlDesigner but am stuck.
