Basically I'm concerned about a remoting server I have. I basically only want known clients making certain calls to it. If someone can get at the server and decompile my assembly I have bigger problems to worry about.

I'm thinking that if I write some custom permission that checks for the strong name identity of the calling assembly (or whatever mechanism makes sense when I get my head around CAS).

You make an interesting point about disabling the CAS. This would probably not be an issue as long as the server is secure – right? Same deal as above.
