Situation: Windows 2003, .NET, developing server.

When I try to debug the webapp, I get the message: 'Unable to start debugging on the web server. You do not have permissions to debug the server. Verify that you are a member of the debugger users group on the server'.

According to the computer management I am member of not only the debugger group, but also the administrators. Thing is that is did work a couple of weeks ago.

I can manually attach the debugger to the w3wp.exe process and start the debugging manually, but that is irritating doing that all the time.

A 2nd developer with the same rights can 'normally' start the debug proces. So it appears that there something has gone wrong with my user account.
