> *I am using Smtplib.Send in a .NET(C#) program to send out a email message. How can I (or can I?) track if the mail is not delivered to the recipient successfully in the same program immediately after sending??*

> *If I send email to, say, xxxx@yyyy.com (assume a not-existing address), I would still send out the mail. The System.Web.HttpException doesn't help as it only captures a "non well-formed" email address (like xxxx without @yyyy.com).*
