I've just been reading about how to create item templates. You put them in the templates folder and they show up in the list of available items when you go Add > New Item > Windows Form. The folder is \Microsoft Visual Studio .NET\Vb7\VBProjectItems\Local Project Items\ and you need the .resx file along with the form file.

I haven't really got this working so I hope someone else will know more.
