I find this hard to believe but I have put in a good amount of time researching this issue.

You mean to tell me I can't create a custom config file and do something like the following:

```
ConfigurationSettings.AppSettings.Load("app.config");  
string connstr = ConfigurationSettings.AppSettings["connstring"].Value
```

I have a queued component that needs a config file. Inside of MSMQ I can pass in a path to the config file. So each time the queued component is called it passes this path inside a function inside the component.

```
Now I have to treat that path like an XML doc?  
XmlDocument xd = new XmlDocument();  
xd.Load(path);
```

You telling me that Microsoft does not have this functionality yet?
I'm shocked!
