Hi, I have an IIS web project for which I created a web deployment project as well.

The web project is in C:\myweb, the deployment is C:\deploy.

After deployment to production, I wanted to put the web project under control in TFS. I created a new team project, added 2 directories DEV and MAIN.

Whenever I try to add the web project or the whole solution to source control, I get the following message box :
