If you are using Oracle you can define a column as an XMLType this will allow you store and retrieve the XML as a column. In order to utilise this it is necessary to download an addition ODP toolkit from Oracle to access it in .Net. There is also the possibility of storing the XML as part of the relational database within Oracle although I haven't used that option yet.
