>I have an ASP.NET (C#) web app on a remote server. Whenever I try to debug

>it, I get:

> "Error while trying to run project: Unable to start debugging on the web
> server. Access is denied."

>

> I did some research on this, and I do have the user as a member of both

> Administrators and Debugger Users. (Machines are on a

> workgroup, so its just a user with the same username/password on the

> remote machine). Aside from the two groups to put the user in,

> I can't seem to find any other suggestions.

>

> The remote server is running Windows Server 2003 (and also has VS.Net 2003

> installed on it). My development environment is Windows XP +SP2 (firewall

> turned off) with VS 2003.

> I could use Remote Desktop to just debug "locally", but I would much

> rather actually do it from the remote machine.
