```
Assembly exeAssmb = Assembly.LoadWithPartialName("CommonStructures");  
//Assembly exeAssmb =  
Assembly.LoadFrom("C:\\Inetpub\\wwwroot\\Vinoth\\CommonStructures.dll");
```

Then when i create an Instance of the Assembly it giving Undefined Value.

```
string instClass = "ManWrapper";  
object inst = exeAssmb.CreateInstance(instClass);  
//object inst = Activator.CreateInstance(exeAssmb.FullName,instClass);
```

This class(ManWrapper) is in CommonStructures and i registered it in gacutil also.

I tried the Commentd line also. What is the problem? Is anybody knows solution please let me know.
