Take a look at ModelMaker www.modelmakertools.com , it is a two-way UML/C# or Delphi CASE tool that integrates into the the Visual Studio IDE. Not only can you visualise code into UML, you can also edit the diagrams and see the changes in your code (or vice versa) What is more, ModelMaker does not rely on completely compilable code, as its OO model is stored independently, with both the code and the diagrams being different views of the same underlying model.
