I have a class with List<AnotherClass> as a property.

Then I try to serialize my entire class with:

```
string ret = string.Empty;
using (MemoryStream ms = new MemoryStream())
{
    SoapFormatter sf = new SoapFormatter();
    sf.Serialize(ms, this);
    ret = System.Text.Encoding.Default.GetString(ms.ToArray());
}
return ret;
```

And it blows up every time saying it can't serialize generics....
"Serializer does not support serializing Generic Types"

When I said cache I was actually referring to the HttpSessionState. I thought if we were using StateServer that the objects were serialized to the server running StateServer?
