Background: I'm a Java programmer new to c# and Visual Studio.

Problem: When I compile in Visual Studio 2005, the compiler complains, that it can not find several different namespaces. Examples:

Error 1 The type or namespace name 'Soap' does not exist in the namespace 'System.Runtime.Serialization.Formatter' (are you missing an assembly reference?)

Error 2 The type or namespace name 'Drawing' does not exist in the namespace 'System' (are you missing an assembly reference?)

When I compile from the command prompt there are no problems. What can be wrong? It seems like Visual Studio is somehow not including the full API.
