I have a windows service that does some distributed transaction across 2 servers. One DB is SQL 2005 express and the other is SQL 2005.

My question is I have created a domain user account and I am logging the service in as that account. Then I am adding permission to the user account to both DB's.

If I use integrated security in my connection strings to the DB's will they login as the domain user account and everything be great????

Yes, this should work, and in fact it is the recommended way to configure security for such a setup.
