Example: You have 2 seperate .exe files running (both written in vb.net)

Is there a way to make 1 exe "listen" on a port or something (other than a text file) so the 2nd exe can transfer a variable to it or an array ?

Currently my solution is that the 1 exe writes a text file and the other goes and reads it.
