I've got an app in VB6 that uses a webbrowser control to go to a web site, enter text in a box, click the Submit button and fetch the results.

Apparently the code won't translate to VB2005. The program stops on this line:

```
WebBrowser1.Document.DomDocument.All("address1").Value = MyString
```

with the error "Object reference not set to an instance of an object" and the Upgrade Warnings above the line of code show:

Couldn't resolve default property of object WebBrowser1.Document.All.

What is the correct syntax for this, or is there a better way of doing this?
