Are you accessing Outlook or POP3 or IMAP?

You can use a 3rd party component like nSoftware's IPWorks... or Indy Sockets.

I'm trying to build a stand alone application, and would rather not put on outlook.

I'm not telling you to install outlook. I'm asking where is your mail stored?

Exchange Server, POP3, or IMAP? :-)

I was looking for a way to do it within VB2005. I guess I kind of assumed MS had some kind of functionality I hadn't been able to find.

There is no built in functionality. You need to write it from scratch (hard) or use a 3rd party component.
