Hi,  
I have an app which has a listbox and when i double click an associated fileS, i want their paths to be added into listbox in my application.

This code works good when i try to open a "single" file with my app which works to get commandline arguments to get file paths:

```
Dim cla As String() = Environment.GetCommandLineArgs()  
If cla.Length > 1 Then  
    ListBox1.Items.Add(cla(1))  
End if
```

But this doesn't work while opening more than one files at the same time.

You are only adding the first item from the command line. Change your code to:

```
Dim cla As String() = Environment.GetCommandLineArgs()  
Dim idx as Integer  
  
If cla.Length > 1 Then  
    for idx = 1 to (cla.Length-1)  
        ListBox1.Items.Add(cla(idx))  
    next idx  
endif
```
