I have the following code to determine a file name when my application is saving a file. The problem is that if the file already exists and I select the Yes button in the "Do you want to replace" dialog, the DialogResult is Cancel instead of OK. Is there something I am missing?

Dim ISaveFileDialog As New SaveFileDialog
```

ISaveFileDialog.AddExtension = True  
ISaveFileDialog.Filter = "PNG (*.png)*.png"  
ISaveFileDialog.InitialDirectory = IDefaultPath  
ISaveFileDialog.OverwritePrompt = True  
ISaveFileDialog.Title = "Save As"
```

Dim IDialogResult As DialogResult = ISaveFileDialog.ShowDialog()
```
