I've a lot of buttons named button1..button100 and want to change some of there propertys.
Maintaining the overview I'm looking for a possibility for something like:

System::Windows::Forms::Button * Wolfgang;

```
for (i=1;i<100;i++)
{
    Wolfgang = ???;
    Wolfgang->BackColor=Color::YellowGreen;
}
```

to avoid:

```
button1->BackColor = Color::YellowGreen;
button2->BackColor = Color::YellowGreen;
button3->BackColor = Color::YellowGreen;
...
```

But I don't know how to fill the gap ??? with code.
