I would like to create an XML structure like so:

```
<Root>
<Reasons>
<Reason>value1</Reason>
<Reason>value2</Reason>
</Reason>
</Root>
```

I figured start with a string[] like so:

```
string[] reasons = new string[] { "value1", "value2" }
```

and then use a foreach to make each element. Can anyone help me out here?

There are very many ways to create XML documents, you can simply print them character for character, you can use an XmlWriter, you can use the serialization features, you can create an in-memory tree using, say, XmlDocument, any many more. You are not providing any information that would help us help you pick one of them suitable for your problem, and so there is little we can help you out with here.
