I have a table with the following columns: Vendor, Component, Purchase Date, Price.

All entries in the Component column are in one of the following five groups: "Processor", "Memory", "Video Card", "Hard Drive", and "Power Supply".

What I'd like to do is be able to sort the table by Vendor first, then by Component, but in the following order for Components: "Processor", "Memory", "Hard Drive", "Video Card", and then "Power Supply". Obviously that list is not in alphabetical order. Is it possible to specify a customized sort list? I've looked in Excel (2003) help, and it mentions using a custom list, but that only seems to work when the cell being sorted with the custom list is the first in the "Sort by" dialogue (in my case, "Vendor").
