Private Sub Worksheet_BeforeDoubleClick( _  
ByVal Target As Range, Cancel As Boolean)  
Cancel = True 'Eliminate Edit status due to doubleclick  
With Target.EntireRow  
.Offset(1, 0).Insert  
.Copy .Offset(1, 0).Cells  
On Error Resume Next  
.Offset(1, 0).SpecialCells(xlConstants).ClearContents  
On Error GoTo 0  
End With  
End Sub
```
