If you can select the range first, it might make it simpler:

```
Sub Uppercase()  
Dim x as Range  
' Loop to cycle through each cell in the specified range.  
For Each x In Selection.Cells  
' Change the text in the range to uppercase letters.  
x.Value = UCase(x.value)  
Next  
End Sub
```

I found a useful macro online but it only selects cells A1:A5 and I need to modify it so I can select a range of cells by highlighting them, and then run the macro. I tried to delete part of the syntax but just get error messages. The macro I have now is:

```
Sub Uppercase()  
' Loop to cycle through each cell in the specified range.  
For Each x In Range("A1:A5")  
' Change the text in the range to uppercase letters.  
x.Value = UCase(x.value)  
Next  
End Sub
```
