Actually, neither your one liner nor my longer variants will work if filename includes a "-". For that, we need something like:

=====  
Option Explicit  
Function fn(str As String) As String  
Dim s1() As String  
s1 = Split(str, "\")  
s1 = Split(s1(UBound(s1)), "-")  
ReDim Preserve s1(UBound(s1) - 1)  
fn = Trim(Join(s1, "-"))  
End Function  
=====
```

And, of course, the above would not work if the description itself contained a dash.
