I have a number of textboxes, which display formatted numbers and currency symbols. I would like to expand my worksheet to include other currencies, like €, ¢, £, etc.

I know that I can set up if then statements to account for users selection of currency, however, That involves an awful lot of duplicate code considering the number of textboxes, and the currencies i would like to support.

the formatted text line looks like this

```
TBPrt.Text = Format(Worksheets("pricing").Range("ad4"), "$##,##0.00")
```

Is there an easy way for me to have that currency symbol be variable based on user selection of currency on the title page. Any assistance on an easier way than just doing if then statements would be greatly appreciated.
