The test sheet did not display correct in the web, I think you may try to post the excel file and your vb6 project files as a zip file and then post in the newsgroup as attachment.(You may also try in the Outlook express)

Also you may try to email to me directly by removing the "online" from my email address.

Based on my test so far, your code seems ok.(I tested with other sample data)

I guess you may try check if the datatype is compatible between the sql and excel file.

What did you declare the according datatype in the SQL server?

You may try to declare all as varchar to see if it will help.
