

Deleting lines with a variable.

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Hello,

In my macro I want to delete some lines depending on a test. I loop through some lines and do a check whether to delete the line. I've a linenumbr stored in a variable i. The range object does not seem to accept my varaible however. If I just enter the variable e.g.

```
Worksheets(asset).Range(i).Delete  
or  
Worksheets(asset).Range(i:i).Delete
```

Excel will not accept it. If I add quotes I get:

```
Worksheets(asset).Range("i").Delete (which is not accepted)  
or  
Worksheets(asset).Range("i:i").Delete (which deletes a column instead  
of a row)
```

So, how do I delete a line with a linenumbr stored in a variable? If it's not allowed to use a variable in the rangeobject, what would be an efficient work around?
