Hi Leon,

Try something like:

```
'=====>>
Private Sub Workbook_Open()
Dim SH As Worksheet
Dim rng As Range

Set SH = Me.Sheets("RENT SHEET") '<<===== CHANGE
Set rng = SH.Range("I24") '<<===== CHANGE

If rng.Value = Date Then
SH.Tab.ColorIndex = 44
ElseIf rng.Value < Date Then
SH.Tab.ColorIndex = 3
Else
SH.Tab.ColorIndex = xlNone
End If

End Sub
'<<=====
```

This is workbook event code and should be pasted into the workbook's ThisWorkbook module *not* a standard module or a sheet module):

Right-click the Excel icon on the worksheet
(or the icon to the left of the File menu if your workbook is maximised)
Select 'View Code' from the menu and paste the code.
Alt-F11 to return to Excel.
