Ooops, spoke too soon. The solution worked in the sense that it produced a blank PivotTable without generating an error but it caused a problem with a date column in the PivotTable that's being grouped.

The PivotTable contains a date column that's grouped by Year and Month. Refreshing with a blank data source destroyed this grouping. My guess is that this is because you cannot grouping a column with blank rows.
