

Function arguments without quotation marks

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Hi group, again. One tricky question (I think). Is it at all possible to pass arguments to a function without using quotation marks? One example:

```
Function t(nome)
t = nome
End Function
```

On cell A1:

```
=t(abc)
```

Doing this I get on the cell the "#NAME?" error, and doing:

```
t = CStr(nome)
```

I get on the cell "Error 2029". However, doing:

```
=t(123)
```

No error happens. I don't know exactly why numbers can be passed without quotation marks (but I think that it's because all non-numbers are characters and characters are strings, maybe?)

Nevertheless, I would like to be able to use custom functions without doing =t("abc"), but instead =t(abc)

Is it at all possible?
