> =IF(AND(A2>1,A2<(B2-C2)),"x")
```

Technically, there should be another argument in the above formula, i.e., the ELSE argument in the IF/THEN statement. One way is

```
=IF(AND(A2>1,A2<(B2-C2)),"X","\")
```

which will return a blank cell if the A2 conditions are not met.
