I'm trying to use a ListBox on an Excel sheet. I have the items which I want to display in the ListBox in the cells "E15:O15". However, when I specify this range in the ListFillRange property, the ListBox on the sheet only displays the first item. If I change the range from a horizontal range to a vertical (ie "E15:E25") then it displays all of the values in the ListBox.

I'm using Office 2000. The documentation on ListBox and ComboBox does not say anything about the ListFillRange being restricted to vertical ranges.

Am I doing something wrong?

Obviously I can work around this problem by re-orienting my data or by using some VBA code. At this point I'm just curious as to why it doesn't work.
