With your formula, you get negative week numbers once you get past December of the year, gradually reducing from -65 to -52.

I think the formula is nothing more complicated than
=INT((A1-DATE(2007,4,6))/7)+1

Rick Rothstein wrote:

```
=INT((DATE(YEAR(A1),MONTH(A1)-1,DAY(A1))-DATE(YEAR(A1) +  
(32 * MONTH(A1)  
+ DAY(A1) < 134), 3, 6))/7)+1
```

For today's date (7 June 2007) both of the above formulas give the answer 9.

However, I calculate that this week is at least UK Tax Year Week No. 10, or possibly 11.
