One more thing,

I had applied the URLScan and lockdown months ago. Our system ran perfectly well until yesterday when we loaded Exchange 2003 Service Pack1.

As i said below, removing the tools sorted the issue.

>I had the exact issues that you are experiencing, except
>i also received errors when trying to delete emails from
>OWA --> i received the following error: Can't delete
>item, item has been moved, deleted or access is denied.
>I found that the issue was caused as i had run the IIS
>lockdown wizard and installed the URLScan filter on the
>same IIS server running OWA 2003.
>I removed the URLScan filter from control panel -->
>add/remove programs and then reran the lockdown wizard,
>which enabled me to remove that program.

>Please read the following article. It does not pertain to
>this exact problem (it's actually about OWA & SUS), but
>will explain how the above tools could potentially keep
>OWA from functioning correctly. If you have loaded the
>URLScan, then i recommend that you go through your
>W3SVC1.log to see whether there are any OWA entries
>rejected by URLScan prior to removing the lockdown or
>URLScan.
