- > *Not exactly sure of what you are trying to achieve, but this maybe something*
- > *to consider:*
- > *1. Set up a mailbox or public folder*
- > *2. Set up a distribution list (probably hidden)*
- > *3. Set up alternative recipient on the mailbox or public folder and check*
- > *deliver to both.*
- > *4. Tell users to send to the mailbox or public folder.*

- > *This will leave a copy of the message and attachment in the mailbox or*
- > *folder and still send it to the list of people. This will not allow you to*
- > *filter the messages going out.*
