> I have SBS 2003 running with Exchange. The users keep getting email in the
> mailboxes that look as if they are in an Asian character set. I am unable
> to

> delete the mail (when I use a substitute command --- subst m:
> \\.\backofficestorage) so that I can browse the mailboxes from the server
> and the users can not see the files in Outlook 2003.

> I can use exmerge to export the email to a pst file, deleted the mailbox,
> recreate the mailbox and then import the mail (using Exmege) and the bad
> mail
> is gone and all is well for a while.

> How do I:

> 1) Eliminate the mail from coming in
> 2) Clean this up without Exmerge, etc...

> I have implemented a SPAM filter (GFI MailEssentials 10.1) and configured
> to
> to only allow "Western Europe and United States" character sets, but they
> still get through.
