Hi,

Does any one how to resolve this question in an exchange 2003 org?

1. on a excahnge 2003 org you have a group of users that need to be able to send internal mail and external (internet) mail.
2. on the same exchange 2003 org you have a group of users that you only want to allow to send messages internal. By no means allow messages to the internet.

I was told the solution to stop the outbound mail to the internet was to create a receipt policy with a smtp address of non-internet registered / non-resolvable name (something like testthis.com). I knew ahead of time this wasnt the solution and tested anyway. The only thing that work obviously was the addresses of the users for the Receipt Policy change (no suprise here) but email was routed external.
